WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 712 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for the contingencies in the county budget; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Budget and Finance administers an Other Post-Employment Employee Benefits (OPEB) Trust Fund that provides for payment of healthcare and life insurance
