WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, amend the Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 712 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the county budget; and

WHEREAS, construction costs for the installation of air conditioning at Parkville MS, Featherbed Lane ES, Scotts Branch ES, Wellwood International ES, and Hawthorne ES are in excess of the amount budgeted in the current 2013 – 2014 Capital Budget; now, therefore
