Human Relations Commission

FOR the purpose of changing the residency requirement for the membership of the Human Relations Commission; and generally relating to the Human Relations Commission.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 3-3-1102(a)
Article 3 - Administration
Title 3 - Boards, Commissions, Committees, Panels, and Foundations.
Baltimore County Code, 2003

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

1 § 3-3-1102. Membership.

2 (a) Composition; appointment of members.

3 (1) The Human Relations Commission consists of 15 members appointed by the
4 County Executive.

5 (2) Of the 15 members of the Commission:

6 (i) One ~~PERSON~~ COUNTY RESIDENT WHO MAY BE A resident of [each]
7 THE councilmanic district must be appointed on the recommendation of the County Council member
8 representing that district; and

9 (ii) Eight members must be county residents appointed without requirements
10 regarding district residence who reflect the ethnic and minority diversity of the county.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
12 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on December 30, 2013.
