AN ACT concerning

Energy Conservation Devices

FOR the purpose of increasing the annual limit on the amount of tax credits that may be granted for energy conservation devices; and generally relating to the Property Tax Credit for Energy Conservation Devices program.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments  
Section 11-2-203.3(e)  
Article 11 - Taxation  
Title 2 - Ad Valorem Taxes  
Baltimore County Code 2003

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:

1 § 11-2-203.3. Property Tax Credit for Energy Conservation Devices.

2 (e) Annual limit on amount of credits granted.

3 (1) During a fiscal year, the total of all tax credits granted under this section may not  
4 exceed [\$250,000.] ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$750,000.

5 (2) Credits shall be granted in the order in which the Director receives the complete  
6 applications under subsection (g) of this section.

7 (3) A complete application that, if granted, would cause the limit set forth in  
8 paragraph (1) of this subsection to be exceeded, shall be granted in the next fiscal year or years and  
9 the order received.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the  
11 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on September 21, 2015.
