## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Neighborhood Commons Overlay District

FOR the purpose of authorizing the application of the N.C. District to certain property owned by Baltimore County; and generally relating to the Neighborhood Commons Overlay District.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments Section 259.14.C.1. Baltimore County Zoning Regulations

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations read as follows:

1	§ 259.14. Neighborhood Commons Overlay District.
2	C. Special regulations for N.C. Districts.
3	1. The N.C. District shall be applied only to a property, or portion thereof, located
4	inside the URDL and:
5	a. Owned by a nongovernmental, nonprofit entity and held for the purpose
6	of community parks, gardens, or natural open space areas;
7	b. Owned as common areas by a community homeowners' association or
8	condominium association organized and operated in accordance with the laws of this state;
9	c. Owned by a state or local government[, other than Baltimore County,] that
10	is undeveloped, environmentally sensitive, or constitutes a passive recreational area; or
11	d. Specifically designated as community open space on an approved
12	development plan.
13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-five
14	(45) days after its enactment.
