A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Social Host – Unruly Social Gatherings

FOR the purpose of amending the pilot program area for social host – unruly social gatherings to include certain areas of East Towson; and generally relating to social host – unruly social gatherings.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Title 7 - Nuisances
Subtitle 1 - General Nuisances on Private Property and on Public Roads

Baltimore County Code, 2003

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

4 Part IV. Unruly Social Gatherings Pilot Program

5 § 13-7-133. Issuance of Citation for Unruly Social Gatherings – Pilot Program.

6 (a) Pilot program area. The “pilot program area” for this Part IV of this subtitle means:

7 (1) The area of East Towson consisting of the area east of York Road, north and west
8 of Stevenson [Road] LANE, [and south of Towsontown Boulevard and Hillen Road] SOUTH AND
9 WEST OF HILLEN ROAD, NORTH OF EUDOWOOD LANE, EAST OF RAILROAD AVENUE,
10 SOUTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE, EAST OF VIRGINIA AVENUE, AND SOUTH OF
11 TOWSONTOWN BOULEVARD.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
13 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on June 8, 2016.
