Polling Place Relocation

Precinct 3 – 4, Bedford Elementary School

The Baltimore County Board of Elections will review and approve the relocation of Precinct 3-4, Bedford Elementary School Gymnasium, on the 28th day of October, 2024 at 9:30 am.

Precinct 3-4 requires relocation from the Bedford Elementary School located at 7407 Dorman Drive in Pikesville, Maryland to the new Bedford Elementary School located at 7320 Campfield Road in Pikesville, Maryland 21208. The new location is approximately .1 miles away. Voting will take place in the gymnasium.

Effective immediately, the relocation is necessary because the construction of the new building is complete and the previous building can no longer be occupied.

This relocation affects approximately 1900 registered voters. By regular, first-class mail, voters assigned to Precinct 3-4 will receive a Voter Notification Card and under separate cover, a letter with the new location address and instructions explaining the change.

The election agency website will be updated and notice will be placed on all social media platforms. A press release will be issued and notice will be continuously posted to all social media platforms. Signage will be installed at the original location directing voters to the new location.

We are working diligently to keep our voters informed of the location change. Our priority is to ensure that every eligible voter is able to participate in the election process without undue burden.
