CONSTRUCTION IN THE 100 YEAR FLOOD PLAIN TWO ELEVATION CERTIFICATES REQUIRED APPLICANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Pursuant the Baltimore County Code (BCC) Article 32, Title 8

Per BCC Sections 32-8-305(A)(9) and 32-8-308

All applicants shall agree in writing to provide two elevation certificates completed by a professional land surveyor.

The first elevation certificate shall be provided at the completion of the first-floor deck certifying that the lowest occupied floor of the structure is at or above the flood protection elevation.

The second elevation certificate shall be provided at the final inspection and shall include all applicable data required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency to be included in the elevation certificate at the time of finished construction.

Lowest floor elevation for habitable space for all buildings in the floodplain: Elevation not less than 2 foot above Flood Protection Elevation ("FPE")

All elevations shall be referenced to the North American Vertical Datum of 1988 ("NAVD 88")
