- \$22 Million
- Design and construction funded
- Anticipated construction start Fall 2024



Essex Branch New Building

- New property acquired by County
- \$6 Million in State and County Funding for Design
- Need: Construction Funding

- \$12 Million state funding
- Feasibility/design phase
