One additional page can be provided per project.” However, Addendum 3, 3.2 (page 3) states, “Each project description is not to exceed one page typed at MS Arial 12 or equivalent, normal font and paragraph spacing.” Please clarify the page limit for SF 255 Section 8 projects.

Question: Addendum 3, page 3 section 2). Can you clarify the meaning of the underlined text “run over any cartographic unit acceptable for the respective client”?
